His addiction has been healed, but because he once sold drugs he therefore had an income. Now he can no longer justify drug dealing. He said he and his two daughters are facing eviction and homelessness this Saturday. We had a very honest discussion - no 'gushing theories or borrowed speeches' (Mrs. Eddy was so right-on with that statement). Bob asked if we could pray for him and his little family. He said yes. I invite you all to join us in pushing back the aggressive suggestion that God guides someone into the light and then flips off the switch.
